LYMPHATIC THERAPY

Our therapists have been trained through the Norton School of Lymphatic Therapy and the Academy of Lymphatic Studies. Students at these schools receive a thorough training in the Foeldi Method of Complete Decongestive Therapy (CDT), which is regarded as the gold standard for the treatment of lymphedema by the International Society of Lymphology as well as Vodder Manual Lymph Drainage techniques (MLD). CDT is a combination of MLD, multi-layer compressive bandaging, remedial exercises to aid in fluid return as well as skin and nail care.

By receiving certification in the treatment of lymphedema, you can be sure your therapist has a complete understanding of the anatomy, physiology, and pathophysiology of the lymphatic system, the treatment of primary and secondary lymphedema, the indications and contraindications of CDT, and the proper measuring techniques for lymphedema support garments.

The McKenzie Method® of Mechanical Diagnosis and Therapy® (MDT) is an approach for the management of spinal and extremity problems. It consists of a reliable and research proven process for the assessment and treatment of musculoskeletal conditions, which encourages active patient involvement and participation in the management of their symptoms. The McKenzie Method® is one of the most recognized philosophies of treatment for musculoskeletal disorders in the world. The management strategy recognizes the biopsychosocial nature of musculoskeletal pain and encourages effective patient management.

LSVT BIG AND LSVT LOUD

LSVT BIG is an intensive, amplitude-focused physical and occupational therapy approach developed from principles of the effective Parkinson's specific speech treatment LSVT LOUD.

LSVT LOUD is the first speech treatment with Level 1 evidence and established efficacy for treating voice and speech disorders in people with Parkinson's disease (PD) with application to other neurological disorders.

PELVIC FLOOR THERAPY

A pelvic floor therapist is specially trained to help women (and occasionally men) deal with pelvic floor dysfunction. They specialize in treating the muscles, nerves and connective tissues in the pelvic area. Through postgraduate education and certifications, these therapists are highly trained to evaluate and treat many types of pelvic floor pain and conditions.

VESTIBULAR REHABILITATION

Certified through the American Institute of Balance, our clinicians evaluate and treat vestibular disorders and concussion-related symptoms, including dizziness, balance deficits, and visual disturbances. Treatment includes repositioning maneuvers, balance retraining, and individualized rehabilitation using evidence-based practices to improve function and recovery.
